Camp with us on North Stradbroke Island. We stay at a private campsite, with access to a beautiful lake where you can kayak, swim and SUP. We travel the island by 4WD to spend time at many of the beautiful places the island has to offer such as Brown lake, North Gorge. All our activities are "challenge by choice" and there is never any pressure to complete activities. You can jump from the jetty, enjoy swimming, or chill in the sand, try your skill at making a sand turtle or sandcastles.

Point Lookout and the North Gorge walk is amazing, and you may see turtles, dolphins, whales or manta rays, depending on the time of year.
